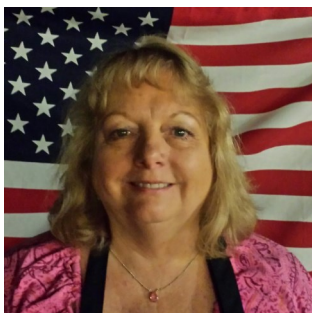
FROM THE WORTHY PRESIDENT
